

IT'S ALL CANNABIS

As Regulated by the Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services



581.217/1004.4473 State Hemp Program

This statute regulates the USDA -approved program to cultivate, manufacture, and sell of hemp- this is Cannabis under .03% THC.



Approved Seed Production

Only Cannabis plants with less than .03% THC can be cultivated under the State Hemp Program. Special seeds are needed for the low THC.



License Growers

Anyone can apply for a license to grow hemp. They submit a plan, register the property, and agree to inspections..



Inspect Production

Products made of hemp oil extract are required to meet all existing food production safety standards.



License Retail Sales

By rule, only retailers with a special license may sell hemp products. Advertising is not regulated by the Department.

IT'S ALL CANNABIS

As Regulated by the Department of Law Enforcement



Florida Statute 893.2 Drug Abuse Prevention & Control

This statute makes all parts of the Cannabis plant, growing or not, seeds and compounds a crime.



Possession of Cannabis

All possession of less than 20 grams of Cannabis containing over .03% THC is a misdemeanor. The only way to measure THC content is in a certified marijuana testing lab.



Felony Possession

Anyone with over 20 grams of Cannabis, Cannabis seeds, or Cannabis concentrates is guilty of a felony. Unless that person is exempt under the medical marijuana law or the hemp law.



Possession with Intent

The sale of any Cannabis without a license is a felony. A possession with intent charge doesn't require actual sales to take place.



Driving Under the Influence

There is no legal limit for use of Cannabis while driving. Patients face penalties like everyone else despite their legal status.

IT'S ALL CANNABIS

As Regulated by the Department of Health



381.986 Medical use of marijuana

This statute implemented the 2016 Constitutional Amendment - this is Cannabis over .8% THC.



Licenses Doctors

Doctors with special training are permitted to write recommendations for products sold by licensed Medical Marijuana Treatment Centers MMTC's.



License Producers

Businesses that grow medical-grade Cannabis, process and package their products, and manage retail sales compete to be licensed as MMTC's.



Certify Testing Labs

Testing Labs get specialized accreditations to be qualified as a Certified Marijuana Testing Lab.



Patients and Caregivers

Patients whose doctor recommends Cannabis must have their case approved before receiving authorization to purchase from an MMTC.
